

Cuffley – Stage 8 Hearing Sessions: Jobs & Travel to Work Data

The information presented below follows up from the stage 8 hearing sessions on proposed allocated sites in Cuffley. Various statistics on the number of jobs, economically active population and methods of travel to work were discussed at the session on 27th August 2020. Following the hearing sessions Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council and Northaw & Cuffley Parish Council have agreed the following data.

Workplace Population

Including: those working from home, residents with no fixed place of work, those commuting in to Cuffley for work and those who both live and work in Cuffley.

Definition of workplace population from ONS: “The workplace population of an area is an estimate of the number of people working in the area, both residents (including both home workers and resident workers with no fixed place of work) and non-resident commuters into the area. Note that only commuters who are resident in either England or Wales are included”

More recent data from the ONS Business Register and Employment Survey 2018 indicates 1,750 employee jobs in the ward of Northaw & Cuffley:

Definition from NOMIS: “An employer survey of the number of jobs held by employees...The survey records a job at the location of an employees workplace. The figures include businesses registered for PAYE but not for VAT.”

Jobs in Cuffley

There is no known data source for the number of jobs physically located in the various commercial premises (i.e offices, retail, industrial etc.) in Cuffley occupied by residents of Cuffley. At the hearing sessions Northaw & Cuffley Parish Council provided an **estimate of around 250-350 jobs based on their local knowledge of the area.**

Distance travelled to work

Data on the distance travelled to work from the 2011 census may give some idea of the number of people who live and work in **Northaw & Cuffley (ward)**. This shows that **117 persons travel less than 2km to work and 113 persons travel between 2-5km** (this excludes those working from home and those who have no fixed place of work). The data is based on those aged 16-74 in employment the week before the census.

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council and Northaw and Cuffley Parish Council consider that based on historic census data and the Parish Council's own estimates that a more realistic figure of those people who live and work in Cuffley is between circa 120 and 350.
