I understand that there is now a proposal for 60 or 70 houses to be built at the end of The Meadway. I live in The Meadway and, as the road is so narrow, it is already difficult to access your driveway when another car is parked opposite. I am wondering where the road was measured and in how many places.

Because of the volume of traffic already using Station Road, it is often difficult for cars to enter or exit The Meadway and this is likely to get even worse given the amount of new housing currently planned for Cuffley and Goffs Oak.

The Meadway is made up of 70 dwellings and there are several flats on one corner where access and exit is via The Meadway, plus I understand that planning has been granted for 16 flats on the other corner, where the access would also be via The Meadway.

I therefore strongly object to the increase in number to 60 or 70 at the end of The Meadway.
