HANDSIDE 4 – MONITORING REVIEW – NOTICE OF INTENTION

Following on from the commencement of new restrictions in September 2021, and subsequent further correspondence with residents; the final amendments are now due to be advertised which will conclude the parking consultation in Handside. The new proposed restrictions are as follows:

- **Marsden Close** – Creation of new resident permit parking scheme, Zone A14, Mon-Sat, 8am-6pm together with additional double yellow lines in turn around area.
- **Springfields House** – addition of short length of double yellow lines in parking area to prevent obstruction of footpath to residential block.
- **Brocket Close** – removal of length of double yellow lines on northwest kerblines.
- **Stanborough Green** – additional double yellow lines to prevent obstruction of garages.
- **Guessens Court** – additional double yellow lines to prevent obstruction of car parking area.
- **Lemsford Lane** – short extension to A13 permit zone.
- **Stanborough Lane** – new length of carriageway to be incorporated into existing verge protection order.

The proposals will be advertised in the Welwyn Hatfield Times on **12 January 2022**. Public notices and maps will also be erected on lamp columns in the affected roads. Formal objections to the proposals can be made before **3 February 2022**. Any formal objections will be presented and considered at Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel on **10 March 2022** and decisions ratified at the Cabinet meeting on **29 March 2022**.
