

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING**

**THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, HATFIELD RISE, HATFIELD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING, PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED BAYS) ORDER 2022**

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce various parking restrictions as listed below in **Various Roads, Hatfield**

Restrictions are being proposed in advance of the completion of the development of Hatfield Rise where new roads and road layouts will be in place, and restrictions to enable parking for residents in properties without off street parking as well as visitors to local business premises upon opening.

The proposed restrictions are as follows:

**Double yellow lines (No waiting at any time), affecting parts of**

- Harrier Way, High View, Hilltop Way, McDonald Court, Summit Way

**1 hour limited stay, no return within 4 hours OR B04 Resident permit holders Monday to Sunday 8am to 8pm, affecting parts of**

- High View

**3 hours limited stay, no return within 4 hours OR B04 Resident permit holders Monday to Sunday 8am to 8pm, affecting parts of**

- Harrier Way, Hilltop Way, Summit Way

**Disabled badge holders only at any time, affecting parts of**

- Harrier Way, High View, Hilltop Way, Summit Way

**Electric Vehicle Charging only, 3 hours limited stay, no return within 4 hours Monday to Sunday 8am to 8pm affecting parts of**

- Hilltop Way

**Loading only at any time bay, affecting parts of**

- High View, Hilltop Way

**Car Club Permit Holders CC01 only at any time, affecting parts of**

- Hilltop Way

Having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council consider that it is necessary and expedient to make Orders for the following reasons:-

- For the purposes of relieving or preventing congestion of traffic.
- For the avoidance of danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and county councillors representing the area and Hertfordshire County Council. Hertfordshire Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Service. Local residents and businesses have also been consulted.
