Dear Mr. Salter

Would you be so kind as to circulate this email to the Inspector, Messers. Young, Thomas and Cannon as I was unable to provide the explanation in person to the Inspector on Friday. The session overran the scheduled 12pm and as I had made arrangements to attend another appointment, was unable to put the information before the hearing.

In regard to the North Mymms Parish Plan provided on CD12 item 12.28 please note that after wide consultation in the Parish in 2011 the Plan listed in the core documents was compiled. However, almost immediately after production and distribution, the Government introduced the Neighbourhood Plan Scheme.

Unfortunately, by this time the Parish had little by way of funds, expertise or manpower and the Parish Council decided to use the Parish Plan as an informal Neighbourhood Plan. This seemed a good interim measure in view of

the fact that the consultations and questionnaires used to produce the plan had been so extensive, and had engaged so many members of the community.

As there was never a period after that time when the Parish had sufficient funds or expertise to produce a replacement in accordance with the Government's new scheme, the Parish Council waited for the release of the Emerging Local Plan.

I trust this is sufficient, but if there are any other queries in respect of the Parish Plan do let me know and I shall endeavour to provide the information.

Please note that our Parish Clerk is away on holiday this coming week, therefore any immediate questions in respect of the above would be better directed towards me so that I can ensure you receive a timely response.
