Newsletter 03 – Update

Dear Residents,

Thank you for some of your comments about the project, here is a quick spring update:

We are now fully mobilised and are in the full swing of treatment works. We have treated many of the historical mineshafts within the Copse and will now be concentrating on treating the area of wood closest to Chantry Lane. The open mineshaft will be left open for a few more weeks before being demolished at a later date.

We now have three drilling rigs on site which have spread out from area 1, with treatment of individual properties underway. For other residents, we will continue to issue Individual Action Plans as works progress towards your property. To date we have placed over 450m³ of grout, equivalent to over four double decker busses in volume.

We have also completed six areas of ground investigation. The remaining investigation and subsequent sampling should be complete by the end of the month. For those residents affected by this, we will let you know if we need to carry out any further works.
